Veteran's Scoring Criteria Status In Examinations

To claim Veteran's Preference Point, submit a copy of your DD-214 in entirety (sections 1-30), complete and sign this form.

In accordance with State law RCW 41.04.010, 41.04.005 certain veterans as defined in RCW 41.01.007 are eligible to receive a scoring criteria status in examinations. A scoring criteria status is the addition of a percentage to the "passing mark, grade or rating" received in a competitive examination by a veteran. **All veterans' scoring criteria may be claimed UPON RELEASE FROM ACTIVE MILITARY SERVICE.**
